



Participants Needed for a National Survey of Independent Nurse Practitioners (NP) in Primary Care

The American Academy of Nurse Practitioners Network for Research (AANPNR) is joining with the Institute for Nursing Centers (INC) to collect standardized national data on independent primary care services provided by advanced practice nurses.

INC developed the only national standardized database on nurse managed health centers providing primary care. These data are used to inform policy as well as local, state, and national stakeholders about the important role of independent NP practice within primary care. Data collected include patient characteristics, services provided, and financial information.
